

Terms and Conditions – Adult Soft Play

1. General Information

- These Terms and Conditions apply to all participants attending the Adult Soft Play sessions at Brixton Recreation Centre
- By booking or attending, you agree to abide by these terms and any instructions provided by staff.

2. Eligibility

- Participants must be **21 years or older** to attend Adult Soft Play sessions.
- Valid photo ID may be required upon entry.

3. Booking & Payment

- All bookings must be made in advance via our website or at the venue.
- Full payment is required at the time of booking.
- Bookings are non-refundable unless cancelled by the venue.

4. Safety & Conduct

- Participants must wear appropriate clothing and footwear (e.g., no heels, sharp accessories).
- No food, drink, or chewing gum is allowed in the play area.
- Alcohol consumption is permitted only in designated areas. Intoxicated individuals will not be allowed to participate.
- Aggressive, disruptive, or unsafe behaviour will result in removal from the venue without refund.

5. Health & Liability

- Participants take part at their own risk. The venue is not liable for injuries sustained due to misuse of equipment or failure to follow safety instructions.
- If you have any medical conditions that may affect your participation, please consult your doctor before attending.
- The venue is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.

6. Photography & Media

- The venue may take photos or videos during events for promotional purposes. If you do not wish to be included, please inform a staff member upon arrival.

- Personal photography is allowed, but please respect the privacy of other guests.

7. Venue Rights

- The venue reserves the right to refuse entry or remove any participant who breaches these terms.
- The venue may cancel or reschedule events due to unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, a full refund or alternative date will be offered.
